


13 Barnstaple

-Visitor's top tips

Visit Woolacombe beach for a lovely walk on golden sands with views of Lundy Island.

Walk to Ilfracombe along the old railway line and explore the tunnel beaches.

Try the walk to Bull Point Lighthouse from Woolacombe using the coastal path.

Morte point and Rockham Bay are a must. We had an excellent meal in the Ship in Mortoe. A visit to Croyde Bay and Saunton Sands are a must.

Take a visit to Marwood Gardens, it's lovely.

The Rock Pub and Restaurant at Georgeham has some fine local beers and an outstanding menu.
