EASY | 7 MILES THERE AND BACK



FERRY MEADOWS CYCLE ROUTE

This great short route takes you directly from the Caravan Site and through the beautiful, 500 acre Ferry Meadows Country Park. The route travels along the River Nene and takes you right into the city centre. Peterborough has a wealth of attractions including its impressive Norman Cathedral which boasts a magnificent West Front, Peterborough Museum and the Nene Valley Railway.

SURFACES

Tarmac or fine gravel paths and flat.

TRAFFIC

Traffic-free

SUITABILITY FOR YOUNG CHILDREN

Yes, but care should be taken and children should remain under supervision at all times.

HILLS

No hills.

REFRESHMENTS/FACILITIES

The Ferry Meadows café is near Overton Lake and there are also BBQ stands by Coney Meadow Pond.

OTHER ROUTES IN THE AREA

The Peterborough Green Wheel is made up of one 45-mile circular route that passes through picturesque countryside and villages, with spokes leading directly back to the city's historic, pedestrianised centre.



DIRECTIONS

- 1 Head right out of the site and at the fork in the road turn left into Ferry Meadows Country Park and onto National Cycle Route 63.
- 2 Along the way, you will pass close to Orton Water and Osier Lake, which are great stopping off points for a picnic and some wildlife spotting.
- 3 Turn left at the next fork and continue on the cycle path, crossing the River Nene.
- 4 Continue on the route and you will pass the Rowing and Canoeing coarse and the Boathouse at Thorpe Meadows.
- 5 Keep following the path along the river and you will arrive in central Peterborough at the Lido and Bishops Road Gardens.
- 5 Return by the same route in reverse.
